On average, the number of drivers on the road at any given time doubles during Labor Day Weekend, meaning you are much more likely to be in a car accident. While you may be excited to visit family or reach your vacation destination, driving safely and taking precau-tions before and during the drive is vital. Before leaving, take these precautions to ensure you safely drive during your Labor Day getaway.

INSPECT YOUR VEHICLE

Inspect your vehicle before leaving. Confirm all headlights, taillights, windshield wipers, brakes, etc., are working correctly. Keep emergency safety kits, and review state laws where you will be driving. When driving, ensure everyone is always wearing their seat belts and remove anything that can cause distracted driving.

CHECK THE WEATHER AND ROUTE

Check the weather and terrain of the route you will be driving. Memo-rize the path you will be taking to avoid having to check the GPS repeatedly or hoping to hear the GPS over the family talking during the drive.

BRING WATER

Keep water nearby during the drive to stay hydrated. Dehydration during a long drive can cause fatigue and lower alertness, decreasing your ability to drive safely. Bringing food snacks will also reduce fatigue, but eating during a rest stop and not while driving is much safer.



BRING YOUR PHONE & CHARGERS

Charge your cellphone before leaving. Bring a car cellphone charger and a portable charger to contact help if anything happens.

PLAN REST STOPS

Do not wait until you are already tired and nodding off to make a rest stop. Make plans for rest stops every few hours. Keep everyone safe and your mind fresh for when you arrive at your destination.
